YOUTH APPRENTICESHIPS

The Youth Apprenticeship program allows high school Juniors and Seniors an opportunity to explore and gain experience in a career area of interest. Students earn high school credit and earn wages as they are guided by a local business mentor. Apprenticeships are available in over 50 different career program areas.

In a trailer with 5 students in 1999, Lake Country Lutheran High School was started. It quickly grew into a comprehensive high school accredited by AdvancEd. Ten years later, 199 students moved from the old YMCA to the new campus we are in today.
